

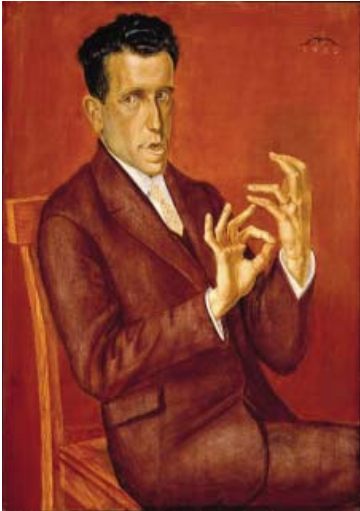

The lecture will be held in french

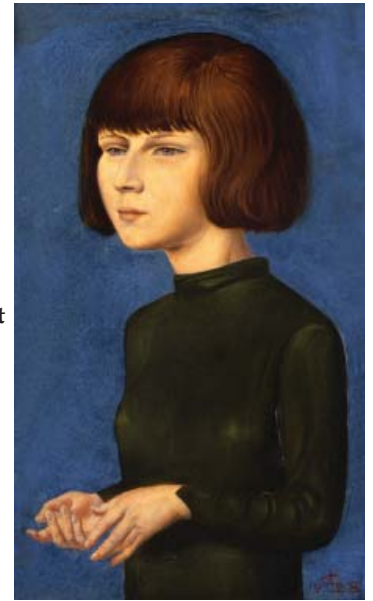
