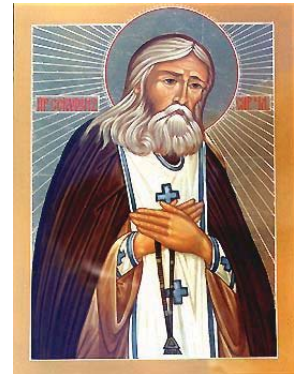


Le solitaire, by Nancy Lajeunesse
